Cem Uzun is Professor of Otorhinolaryngology, Head and Neck Surgery at Trakya University Faculty of Medicine, Edirne, Turkey. He worked at the same department as a resident (1991-1995), specialist (1995-1997), assistant professor (1997-2000), associate professor (2000-January 2006) and full professor since January 2006. He was the General Secretary (2016-2018) and Pro-Rector of the Trakya University (2016-2019), where his responsibilities included university publications, ethics, library, and the Balkan Universities Association - of which his university is the founder and permanent general secretary.

Cem Uzun is also the Founder and Chairman of the Mirko Tos Ear and Hearing Research Center (since January 2019).
